



Referrals for Neuropsychological Evaluations

The following process for referring students for Neuropsychological Evaluations is as follows:

- Students are advised to consult their insurance policy, to see whether it covers neuropsychological testing.
- If covered, the student can pursue neuropsychological evaluators who take their insurance.
- The Office of Accessibility and Disability Resources (ADR) and the Stone Center Counseling Service can assist students in locating evaluators.
- The Counseling Service William James College (WJC) Interns are available to provide testing to a very limited number of students each academic year. Preference is given to those with clinical need and great financial need.
- Referrals to the WJC Interns can come from either ADR or Counseling.
- Referrals to neuropsychological evaluators would include either (a) an initial assessment of whether testing is indicated and/or; (b) providing a full neuropsychological evaluation.
- If a neuropsychological evaluation recommends accommodations, the student is required to register with ADR. In this instance, it is advisable to share a copy of the neuropsychological evaluation with ADR.
