What Employees Should Know about Building Evacuations



When you hear the fire alarm, stop what you are doing

- Leave immediately & close your office/room/lab door
- Walk to the nearest exit, do not use elevators
- Proceed to the designated safety area outside

If you discover a life threatening emergency

- Alert others in the building
- · Activate the fire alarm pull station
- Evacuate the building
- Contact Campus Police

Don't Put Others in Danger!

Evacuate Immediately Upon Hearing the Alarm

Practice good housekeeping and be prepared:

- · Keep aisles and egress paths clear
- Do not block fire safety equipment
- Properly manage hazardous operations know emergency shutdown procedures if needed
- Locate at least two exits from your work area
- Know where the fire alarm pull stations are located
- Know where fire extinguishers are located and only use them for escape purposes unless you are training otherwise
